Charlotte Seymour will represent KHSD and the ACT in Sydney on 26 May.


KHSD is proud to have had many students represent ACT in the bursary finals over the years, including:

After finishing his studies at the Australian Ballet School, Matthew danced for companies in France, Switzerland, Italy and Germany. He toured the world, performing in over 30 countries. His favourite memory as a dancer was playing the Prince in Sleeping Beauty at La Fenice, the opera house in Venice. His first position as ballet master was in Nuremberg, Germany. He worked as a

ballet master in three other companies before starting in Leipzig ballet, where he stayed as ballet master for 9 years. Matthew has staged over 70 ballets for companies, taught classes all around the world from Cape town city ballet to Dresden Semperoper and has assisted some of the most famous choreographers in the world. Favorite ballets that he staged include "Walking Mad" by Johan Inger, "Decadance" by Ohand Naharin, and "Rachmaninow" by Uwe Scholtz and Mario

Annelies left Australia in 2000 to study at the prestigious Heinz-Bosl Stiftung in Munich, now known as the Bayerisches Junior Ballett Műnchen, Germany. After graduating, she spent the next two decades dancing for several companies in Germany, including as a soloist for the Mecklenburgisches Staatstheater

Schwerin and the Anhaltisches Theater Dessau, before culminating her career as a soloist in Leipzig. Annelies danced many soloist and principal roles such as Bianca in The Taming of The Shrew, Swanhilda's friends in Coppelia, and Beatrice in Much ado about Nothing. Her final role was dancing the title role of Carmen, created especially on Annelies in Leipzig. She also featured in musicals such as West Side Story, Rocky Horror picture show, and Jesus Christ Super Star during this time.


Hair should be neat and properly up for class. It is just as important as a school or sport uniform. Having your hair in a bun is a part of ballet class etiquette.

It's easier than it looks and can be done quite quickly.

It just takes practise.

ALL classical classes require a bun.





Twist the entire pony tail . . .

... then coil the twist around the elastic band pinning as you go.

Tuck the end under the outside coil and pin. Cover with hair net



The pins will work best if they catch both the underside of the bun and the hair closest to the head.


With very long or very thick hair, split the pony tail in half, make a bun with one half and then twist the other half around the outside of the bun, keep it flat to the head.

Use hair pins like these ...

UNCH NANG Character shoes must be worn for graded exams. and These are available in two heel sizes – low heel in sizes 3 – 7 (including half sizes) and Cuban in sizes 2 – 8 (including half sizes).
